

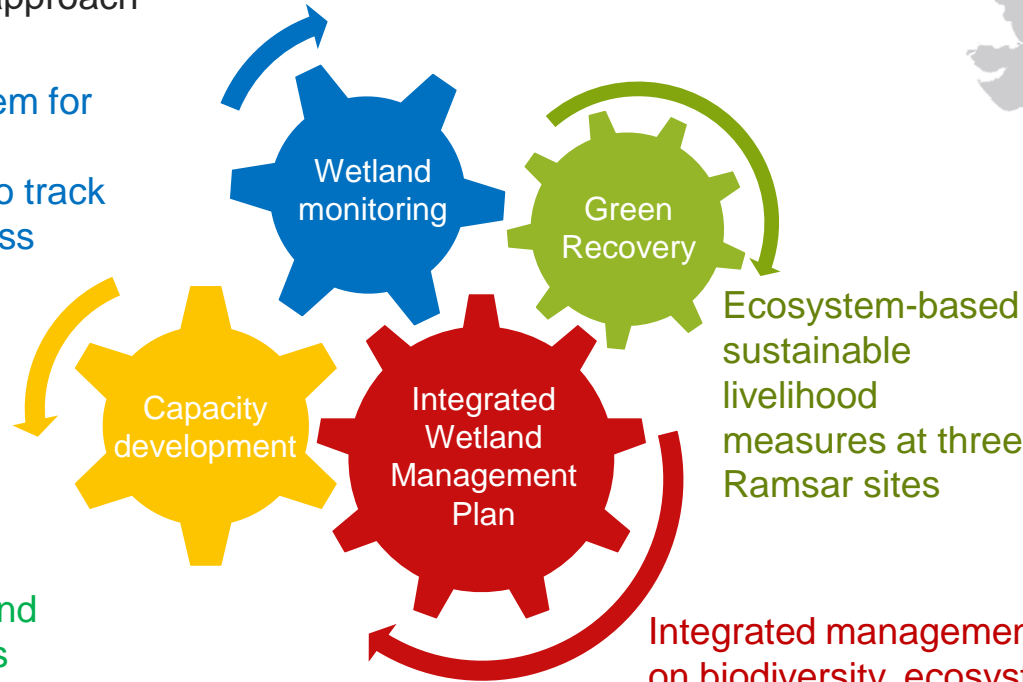
# Wetlands Management for Biodiversity and Climate Protection

## Project objective and outputs

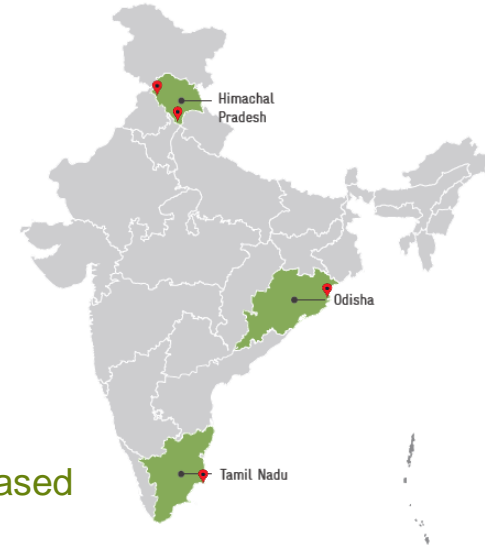
Ramsar sites (3-4) in India are managed according to an ecosystem-based integrated management approach

Integrated wetland management capacity and institutional framework is strengthened in project states

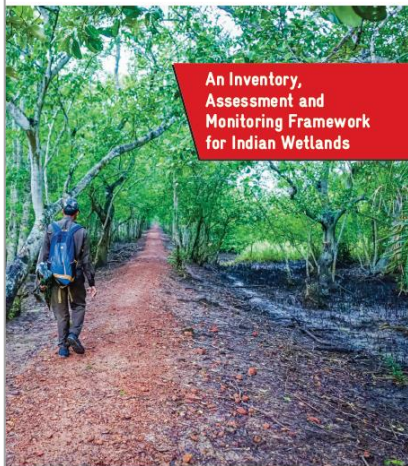


Integrated management plans based on biodiversity, ecosystem services and climate change risks are prepared for selected Ramsar sites
